1. John Butcher. Resided in Althorp, Northamptonshire, England, in 1704. Will signed on 22 Jan 1704 Althorp, Northamptonshire, England. Probate on 26 Apr 1706 London, England. Prerogative Court of Canterbury. Occupation: Yeoman.

John married **Sarah**.

They had the following children:

- i. Edward. Born ca 1696. Will signed on 27 Jun 1749 St. Johns, Southwark, Surrey, England. Edward died in St. John Parish, Southwark, Surrey, England, on 30 Jul 1749; he was 53. Buried on 2 Aug 1749 in Southwark, Surrey, England. Probate on 10 Aug 1749. Occupation: Tallow Chandler.
London & Middlesex records say he died on 30d 5m 1749 of consumption, and was buried on 2d 6m in Long Lane Burying Ground.

On 22 May 1729 when Edward was 33, he married **Mary Hopkins**, daughter of Benjamin Hopkins (22 Dec 1685-1 Sep 1730) & Sarah Haddon (9 Dec 1687-13 Jun 1758), in Horsleydown Meeting, Southwark. Born on 3 Mar 1709 in St. George's Parish, Southwark, Surrey, England. Will signed on 11 Sep 1759 St. Johns, Southwark, Surrey, England. Mary died in Southwark, Surrey, England, on 18 Sep 1786; she was 77. of Horslydown Lane. Buried on 24 Sep 1786 in Bermondsey, Southwark, Surrey, England. Long Lane Burial Ground. Probate on 26 Sep 1786 St. Johns, Southwark, Surrey, England.

3d 1m 1708/9 Mary Hopkins Daughter of Benjamin and Sarah Hopkins of ye Parish of George's Southwark was Borne the Third day of ye First Month Seventeen hundred & Eight.

Mentioned in John Haddon's will of 16-Jul-1723, and left £300.

Mentioned in her father's will of 8-Oct-1728, and left £200.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Loving Daughter Mary the Sum of two hundred Pounds to be payd her when She Shall have attained the age of One and twenty Years or on the day of her Marriage which Shall first happen Provided Such Marriage be with the consent of my Said Executrix.

In her will, she gave money to the children of her sister, Elizabeth Etherington, and to Ann, the daughter of Haddon Hopkins.

- iii. William. Resided in Buckingham, Buckinghamshire, England. Occupation: Farmer.
- iv. Mary. Resided in Hinton, Northamptonshire, England.

On 1 Dec 1718 Mary married **Richard Hall** in Hinton, Northamptonshire, England.

Sarah married **Richard Perkins**. Occupation: Farmer of Westbury, Northamptonshire.
